Printed Learning Package Pick-up & Drop-off/Personal Item Pickup

This Tuesday (April 7th), and following Tuesdays, we will have pick-up times at the school for those who need to **pick-up personal items, pick-up printed learning packages and sign-out school-owned Chromebooks**. This needs to be a deliberate process to ensure we are meeting

the guidelines set out by the Chief Medical Health Officer. We are asking anyone who still has a lock on their locker to come this Tuesday. On Wednesday, we will begin the process of cutting off locks that are still present. This week, we will also be sending home any left over supplies that are still at school. These items will be organized by student name and available at the front lobby.

Here is the process that we have planned:

- Please arrive at the designated times listed below, based on your last name.
- If at any point we reach 15 people in the lobby, we will post a sign on the door that asks people to wait in line until people have left. If this happens, please maintain 2 metres between people in the line.
- We recommend against bringing students, but will allow them to enter the school if other childcare arrangements cannot be made.
- If you are unwell, please stay home and we will make other arrangements.
- Our staff will greet you in the main lobby and provide you with directions.
- You will be asked to wash/sanitize your hands as you enter.
- It is critical for us to follow the norms of social distancing and keep visits short.
- If you feel uncomfortable with coming into the school for any reason, please contact the office to arrange alternative plans for pickup (780-963-5035).
- Please drop off any school-owned items that you may have at home. Ex. home-reading books, jerseys, etc.
- Families can pick up for others.
- Please, only sign-out a Chromebook if it is needed for access to learning.
- If you would like a printed package, we would appreciate you letting the homeroom teacher know so that we can photocopy enough (but not too many) packages.
