## Online Registration/Verification for 2020-2021

Every student needs to be re-registered for next school year through the online system. So far, 41% of students have completed this registration, but we need everyone registered by March 20th. This process allows us to determine the eligibility of bus pass applicants, the routing of buses, bus pass production and data verification before the summer break while schools are still operating. Any applications received after the March 20 deadline may not be processed in time for the first day of school.

## Kindergarten Registration

Kindergarten registration for the 2020-2021 school year has begun February 3, 2020. There has been a small change to the age of registration rules. The new age rule is that a child entering Kindergarten must be five years old by the last day of December of the school year in which he or she begins Kindergarten. For example, a child registering for Kindergarten in September 2020 needs to be five years old by December 31, 2020.
