- 2. Make an appointment with the school office to drop them off.

Many people have been asking about whether we will be able to offer Band this year. We believe that we have a plan to offer this course safely.

School Entry

Please double check the school entry and exit map in the <u>Graminia Return to School Handbook</u> so your children know where to meet their teachers on the first day. K-6 students will be meeting their teachers outside their doors and 7-9 students will see their teachers outside the first day and then meet them directly in their classrooms. Parents are asked to stay outside of the school and to make an appointment with the office prior to entering.

Supply List Additions

With the new rules that have been put in place, we suggest adding 2 items to the supplies that students come with. These are not required, but may make the school day easier for students. They are:

• Individual Hand Sanitizer - There will be hand sanitizer at all entrances and classrooms, but students may want to have their own sanitizer at their desk.

• Masks - students may want a selection to wear throughout the day or week. We will also have disposable masks for students.

Mental Health Supports

In response to COVID-19, <u>Spruce Grove Family and Community Support Services</u> is pleased to introduce Parkland Connect, a free single session counselling service for residents living in the Tri-Municipal Region.

Topics that will be explored include coping during COVID-19 and goal setting. Counsellors will propose an action plan that builds on the participant's strengths, ideas and abilities, and provide additional resources as required.

AHS will direct any symptomatic person on next steps which must, by law, be followed.

We would appreciate it if parents and guardians could provide additional information when calling about a student missing school because of sickness. It would help us to know which

symptoms the students have and if they need to self-isolate based on the public health laws and AHS direction. We appreciate your help with this new process.
