Parking Lot Safety Reminder

A reminder that our parking lot is a one-way street. The entrance is at the South and the exit is at the North. It helps us to keep everything safe when traffic flows in this direction. In order to ensure the safety of students during pick-up and drop-off we would ask you to follow the following rules:

- If dropping off students in the lane closest to the school, please park in a parking stall following all traffic rules. No dropping off in this lane without correctly parking (no drop and roll).
- If dropping off students in the grass/gravel lane (in front of the totem pole), you may drop students off without parking (drop and roll). This can only happen in this lane, not in the lane closest to the school.
 - Please use the crosswalk when crossing the parking lot in front of the front doors. Thank you for your cooperation. Ms Neumann and Ms Chessor will be out to help

Please make sure that anyone dropping your child off is aware of the rules.


