Track and Field Updates

Track and Field is back at Graminia School! Over the last few weeks, Graminia students have represented our school at 6 different track meets! For the first time in three years we were able to host our school track meets, one for grades 7-9 and one for grades 4-6. Thanks to our parent volunteers and teacher organizers, the students had a great time competing in running, jumping and throwing events.

Our junior high students went on to **win** the aggregate award East Central Zone track meet, with Neka Comeau, Cody Sanders, Maddy Fischer, Arden Sullivan and Blake Korte winning individual aggregate medals for their respective age groups. At the Division meet, our junior high team placed second overall with Cody Sanders and Maddy Fischer once again winning the individual aggregate medal for their age group. Eighteen Graminia athletes had top 3 finishes and moved on to the Zone 5 track meet in Sherwood Park where half of them finished in the top 5 in their event.

After a very successful 4-6 track day at Graminia, 32 students from grades 4-6 proudly represented the school at the division meet at SPC school in Stony Plain. There they competed against nearly 550 other athletes from across Parkland School Division. All of our students competed with heart and did very well, with many students placing in the top 5 in multiple events. Great job Hawks! Congratulations to all our track athletes! Can't
