    - 6.9.1. Vaccination PSD
    - 6.9.2. AHS at home learning when 3 or more cases occur in a 5 day period in grade K-6 from AHS, and/or K-12 from PSD depending on the circumstances and case context
    - 6.9.3. Starting Oct 12 AHS will be informing schools/school divisions regarding cases and the number of cases in our school will be reported from AHS online. We will be sending out letters to the

families of students who have been exposed/close contacts in school while infectious notifications.

- 6.9.4. New Outbreak levels and reporting:
  - 6.9.4.1. AHS has three levels:
    - 6.9.4.1.1. Alert 2-4
    - 6.9.4.1.2. Alert 5-9
    - 6.9.4.1.3. Outbreak 10+
- 6.9.5. Feeling Sick? Here's What to Do UPDATE
- 6.9.6. One of the most important things we can do to keep our school safe is to follow the health screening protocols that Alberta Health Services has put in place. Please remember to complete the AHS daily checklist for your child(ren) before coming to school.
- 6.9.7. If your child has a fever, or cough or shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, or loss of smell or taste, your child must isolate at home for a minimum of 10 days from when symptoms started OR receive a negative COVID-19 test and feel better before returning to activities.
- 6.9.8. If your child has any single symptom (Chills Sore throat/painful swallowing Runny nose/congestion Feeling unwell/fatigued Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea Unexplained loss of appetite Muscle or joint aches Headache Pink eye (conjunctivitis)), even just one, please keep your child home for 24 hours and monitor the symptom. If the symptom is still present or worse, or if an additional symptom were to occur, please complete the AHS online assessment and follow the directions. Please only send your child back to school when feeling better, and symptom-free.
- 6.9.9. When calling the office or leaving a message, please let us know what the illness is, and if there is any follow-up that we should be aware of. (ex. Sore throat, isolating and COVID-19 test on Monday)
