Gramina Cell Phone Rules

At Graminia School, our goal is to help students develop the knowledge, skills, and attitudes to grow as learners, individuals, and social members of society. One part of achieving this goal is our approach to the use of digital devices.

When referring to a personal digital device, we mean a device that is privately owned and whose use is not expressly designed or required for academic productivity. This includes, but may not be restricted to, cellular phones, digital watches, tablets, portable music players, and gaming devices.

#### At Graminia School, our policy for 2022-2023 is as follows:

From the time that students arrive at our building, to the time that they leave the building, students are expected to keep their personal devices in their lockers for the duration of the school day. Phones and other personal digital devices are not to be in student possession in classrooms, hallways, locker rooms, bathrooms, the gymnasium, outdoor facilities including the playground, or on buses during field trips.

This policy also extends to headphones, external speakers, or any other accessory unless it is expressly required by the classroom teacher for academic purposes. If headphones are required for a classroom activity, they need to be wired, with a 3.5 mm jack. As it increases the likelihood of distraction, damage, theft, and incompatibility with school Chromebooks and other work devices, we ask students to keep wireless headphones at home.

We acknowledge that there is a need for students to be able to access their devices at short intervals throughout the day. To that end, students will be allowed to access their personal devices for a reasonably brief period of time at their lockers. This can be at the beginning of the scheduled breaks (morning recess, lunch eating time, and/or lunch recess), as well as at the end of the day. Students seen with a personal device at times other than those specified will have it confiscated and stored in the office until the end of the day. Should this behaviour become a persistent issue, it will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis by administration.

We appreciate the need for parents and guardians to keep in contact with their child, but digitally messaging them during class time largely results in distraction, lost productivity, and probably the confiscation of their device, since they should not have it outside their locker anyway. Therefore, expect that if students are sent digital messages that they will be unable to immediately reply. If parents or guardians need to contact their child, the office phone line is always available at (780) 963-5035, so that in the event of an emergency we can call students down to the office and manage the situation in the most expedient way.

#### **Parking Lot Safety**

For those families that are new to Graminia it is important to note that our parking lot is a **one-way street**. The entrance is at the South and the exit is at the North. It helps us to keep everything safe when traffic flows in this direction. In order to ensure the safety of students during pick-up and drop-off we would ask you to follow

If dropping off students in the lane closest to the school, please park in a parking stall

following all traffic rules. No dropping off in this lane without correctly parking (**no drop and roll**).

• If dropping off students in the grass/gravel lane (in front of the totem pole), you may drop students off without parking (drop and roll). <u>This can only happen in this lane, not in the lane closest to the school.</u>

• It is critically important that students, parents and staff use the crosswalk when crossing the parking lot in front of the front doors. It is not safe to cross from in between parked cars and the Parent Parking areas have cars constantly backing up and moving. As the adults, we can model this for the kids!

Thank you for your cooperation. Ms Neumann and Ms Chessor will be out to support a safe drop off and pick up each day.

#### Covid and our ongoing work to Keep our Staff and Students Safe and Healthy

Graminia and Parkland School Division are excited that the World is Opening Back Up. 2022-2023 should finally start to feel like what a school year is supposed to feel like.

With that being said, there are many measures that were previously implemented that just make sense to continue. Above all, we encourage anyone who is feeling ill to stay home from school. If you are exhibiting any of the key symptoms known for <u>COVID-19</u>, we encourage you to access one of the many test kits that are also available at the school. Meanwhile, PSD will continue the following:

- Hand sanitizer will still be readily available at all schools,
- Students will continue to be reminded of the importance of thorough hand-washing hygiene,
- School staff will ensure that appropriate cleaning of high touch areas will continue,
- The frequency at which air filters are changed in PSD has also been increased and air handling/ventilation equipment in all schools has been adjusted to maximize the number of air exchanges within the schools. All schools will operate filtration systems that meet or exceed the Minimum Efficiency Reporting Values (MERV) 13 air filtration rate, and
- Where practical, entrances and exits can be used to efficiently reduce crowding during high traffic times of the day.
