Illness in PSD Schools

Like the rest of the province, Parkland School Division has experienced a recent increase in absences due to more respiratory illnesses in the community. Most site outbreaks are caused by seasonal respiratory viruses or seasonal norovirus. When illness is identified early and appropriate control measures are implemented in a timely manner, these outbreaks are generally controlled quickly.

If the absence rate due to illness in an individual school reaches above 10 per cent of their student population, we advise Alberta Health Services (AHS). AHS will investigate and if they declare an outbreak, families will receive information from the school with AHS direction. To keep families informed, <u>PSD will now report</u> school absences by Grade level on their website.

Junior High Mixed Reading Comprehension Instruction

This week marked the beginning of a new method of instruction once per week for our junior high students. At the beginning of the year, every student in grade 7-9 completed a Reading Comprehension Achievement Screening Test (RCAT) which helped to identify areas of strength and growth in one of five reading behaviours. Based on this information, all students in each grade level have been mixed and sorted into different classrooms based on their area of growth. They will receive 7 weeks of instruction during this Common Literacy block to boost these skills. Towards the end of January we will re-administer an RCAT assessment to determine progress and shuffle groups. We are looking forward to a great session of learning for our bigger kids!
