Course Name : Building Construction

Course Description : This course is an introduction to working with materials and tools to construct projects. We begin with an overview of safe work procedures and practices and the use of personal protective equipment when working with certain devices. Students will also learn the importance of measurement, in inches and fractional inches, and how to mark to materials accurately for cutting. Students will build their skills in the effective and safe use of different tools and machines as they prepare the pieces that they need to build their projects. As students build their projects they will be expected to develop a sense of care and pride into the construction and appearance of their projects. Each term students will be expected to complete 2 projects that they are assigned.

Final Course Project or Presentation : Completion of two small woodworking projects

Evaluation / Assessment Structure : Students will be evaluated throughout the course in the following areas:

Shop practices and safety

Assembly and use of materials

Presentation of final completed project (student will choose their "best" project for evaluation)
