5. PSD Stakeholders and Parent Engagement Night Update & COSC Meeting - Angie Gehlert

5.1. PSD stakeholder and parent engagement night

- 5.1.1. Event took place at Westview School
- 5.1.2. Group was asked: what are the concerns and accolades you would like to share in PSD currently?
 - 5.1.2.1. Concern: French Immersion students don't have a French Immersion high school option in the division.
 - 5.1.2.2. People were happy that all students have access to school councillors.
 - 5.1.2.3. Happy that additional work and resources are available for gifted children.
 - 5.1.2.4. Breakfast program a strong asset to schools.
- 5.1.3. Focused conversations on student and workplace wellness included the following topics:
 - 5.1.3.1. Elder Violet talked about how to build a sense of community back into schools
 - 5.1.3.2. Develop inclusive school culture
