Full Day Everyday Kindergarten!

We are excited to announce that Graminia School is planning to continue our inquiry-nature based full-time (everyday, all day) Kindergarten for the 2024-2025 school year. If you want to register your child for MyPath: Graminia, you must FIRST complete your registration for Graminia School confirming your child will be in gr 4-9 for the 2024-2025 school year and you must complete the <u>MyPath:Graminia Registration</u>. Once you have completed this registration, the MyPath Navigator and Connections for Learning team will be reaching out to confirm registration, complete the waiver forms and pay for the deposit. If there are not enough registrations to make the program viable, we will cancel the program for the 2024-2025 school year. Confirmation of enrollment will be shared with parents and/or guardians by **the beginning of May.**

Solar Eclipse - April 8



A total eclipse is set to occur on April 8, 2024, spanning from Southern Ontario to Newfoundland and Labrador, with the rest of Canada experiencing a partial eclipse. While these events are awe-inspiring, they also pose potential risks to eyesight if proper precautions are not taken. During a solar eclipse, the Moon moves between the Sun and the Earth, partially or completely blocking the Sun's rays. The danger lies in the fact that even during a partial eclipse (should be about 22% for the PSD region), the Sun's intense radiation can cause severe damage to the eyes. Looking at the Sun directly during an eclipse can lead to solar retinopathy, permanently damaging the retina's light-sensitive cells.

What this means for Graminia:

Safe viewing of the solar eclipse can only occur when the participant **properly** wears eye protection that meets the ISO 12312-2 international safety standard. For this reason:

-all outdoor activities planned for that time will be held indoors instead -if a teacher is planning on organizing a safe viewing event with their class, you will receive an info notice with the option to **opt out** of that activity.



Parking Lot Safety

For those families that are new to Graminia it is important to note that our parking lot is a **one-way street**. The entrance is at the South and the exit is

at the North. It helps us to keep everything safe when traffic flows in this direction. In order to ensure the safety of students during pick-up and drop-off we would ask you to follow the following rules:


• If dropping off students in the lane closest to the school, please park in a parking stall following all traffic rules. No dropping off in this lane without correctly parking (**no drop**

and roll).

- If dropping off students in the grass/gravel lane (in front of the totem pole), you may drop students off without parking (drop and roll). <u>This can only happen in this lane, not in the lane closest to the school.</u>
- It is critically important that students, parents and staff use the crosswalk when crossing the parking lot in front of the front doors. It is not safe to cross from in between parked cars and the Parent Parking areas have cars constantly backing up and moving. As the adults, we can model this for the kids!
 - Please <u>do not park in the bus lane to drop students off!</u> As the weather turns chillier we typically have buses arriving later and it is not safe for there to be students disembarking from buses along with cars coming in and out.

Thank you for your cooperation. Ms Neumann and Ms Chessor will be out to support a safe drop off and pick up each day.

Please make sure that anyone dropping your child off is aware of the rules.



To order, please register your child(ren) into the classes they are in. All families, new and returning, must register each year. Please note if this is your first time ordering, please send cutlery to school with your child(ren) as we do not provide this to them.

Orders can be placed starting on Saturday, with the cut off being firm at 1pm on Thursday for hot lunch the following week. Payment can only be received through PayPal. Payment must be received by Thursday at 1pm, for your order to be accepted. Note, that a PayPal processing fee will be added to your order.
